Worthy State Deputies and District Masters,

Let me introduce myself. I am the Vice Supreme Master from the Fr. Hennepin Province which encompasses Michigan and Ohio. I have been appointed by the Supreme Master, Dennis J. Stoddard, to coordinate fundraising efforts for The Military Scholarship Program in your Jurisdiction.

I have attached two letters explaining the New Program. The intent of this letter is to explain the mechanics of collecting the contributions.

The \$4,000 contribution from each State Jurisdiction is to come from the State Council, councils, assemblies and individuals. Each check must be made out to: THE KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS and have MILITARY SCHOLARSHIP written on the memo line. Send all checks to George A. Dann, 5086 North Belsay Rd., Flint, Michigan, 48506.

This is a five year plan and any funds exceeding the \$4,000 will be credited to the following year for that jurisdiction. After I receive a check, it will be placed on a spread sheet for each individual jurisdiction. The spreadsheet will show the contributor, amount, check number and date received. I will then send the spreadsheet and checks to the Supreme Master's office for deposit in the appropriate account. I will send each State Deputy and District Master a copy of the spreadsheet.

This program is of vital importance to our Catholic military men and women. The Supreme Knight is counting on all of us to work together to make this a successful program. Again the World will be evaluating our commitment to our Military and our Church.

If you have any questions, please contact me using the information at the top of this letter. I will be periodically following up to see how you are progressing. I would like your opinion as to whether you think this goal is achievable in your jurisdiction.
